1.) adept- (adj) highly skilled; expert
(ə-děpt')

2.) encompass- (verb) to include; contain
(ən-kŭm' pəs)

3.) entrepreneur- (noun) a person who organizes, manages, and takes the risk of a business undertaking
(ŏn' trə-prə-nŭr')

4.) eradicate- (verb) to get rid of altogether; wipe out
(ĩ-răd' ĩ-kăt')

5.) homogeneous- (adj) made up of similar or identical parts; uniform throughout
(hŏ' mŏ-jĕ' nĕ-əs)

6.) presumptuous - (adj) too bold; overly confident
(prĕ-zŭmp' chŏŏ-əs)

7.) sordid -(adj) indecent; morally low; corrupt
(sŏr' dĭd)

8.) standardize -(verb) to make uniform; cause to conform to a model
(stăn' dĕr-dĭz')

9.) stint -(noun) a period of work or service
(stĭnt)

10.) stringent -(adj) strictly controlled or enforced; strict; severe
(strĭn' jĕnt)

austere -(adj) without decoration or luxury; severely simple
